

How will my work be graded?

Please see below the new whole school marking system that will be applied to your marked prep work throughout the GCSE course.


It consists of two marks:

- One is an effort mark, which represents how much the teacher feels you have put into completing the task.
- The other is an attainment mark, which represents if the level of work is of the standard expected of you by the teacher.

Why do I have to do homework?

Completing the set prep tasks helps you to extend your learning outside of the classroom. Spending a little bit of time on your own away from distractions will help boost your subject knowledge and therefore help you to improve your grades.

How long do I get to complete the homework?

You will be normally given at least a week to complete the tasks but make sure you make a note of the date when the work was set and when it is due in.

How long will it take me to complete the homework?

All of the tasks are designed to last around 30 minutes, although feel free to spend a little longer on them if you want to improve your grades. You should not need to spend longer than 1 hour completing the work through.

Do I need a computer to complete the tasks?

Most of the tasks will be able to be produced without access to a computer, although using the internet may assist you on some of the research work. Please consult with your teacher if you need to arrange a time to do this. If you print something, please cut and stick it into this booklet for grading.

Can I work with someone else to complete the tasks?

Yes you can although make sure you still work hard to learn the answers as well as completing your own copy of the work.

How important is presentation?

Don't spend hours on the presentation of your work as the content is more important but still try to make it neat and tidy. A poorly presented document in business would probably create a bad impression.

What if I don't know what to do?




What if I can't get the work done in time?

If you are struggling to complete the work for when it is due in make sure you speak to your teacher before the hand in date but obviously try your best to do it.


How can I track my progress?


Draw a diagram on the next page showing the history of a business of your choice. This could include details such as:
